



Guidelines for Catheter Securement with LOCKIT PLUS® Device & Catheter Connector


#### A METHOD OF CATHETER SECUREMENT



Secure catheter insertion site with Steri-Strip® material.




Secure catheter with LOCKIT PLUS® device approximately 1" away from the catheter insertion site.



STEP 3b

Attach catheter to the catheter connector (refer to the next page for detailed instructions) then using the Grip-Lok® as shown, secure the extra catheter and catheter connector.



Secure the whole system under Tegaderm® dressings. The 6" injection set can be attached to the catheter connector to provide easy access for pump attachment.

### CONNECTING THE CATHETER TO THE CATHETER CONNECTOR

Insert the catheter through the opening of the catheter connector as shown.

#### **IMPORTANT:**

- Ensure the catheter connector is fully open with the two halves rotationally out of alignment before inserting catheter (see insets).
- Wipe off any excess ultrasound gel from the catheter prior to inserting it into the catheter connector.
- The catheter is secured when the black marker on the catheter is inside the groove of the catheter connector and the halves are rotationally aligned with an audible/tactile "click" to indicate complete closure.
- Avoid closing and opening the catheter connector several times as that could reshape and close the internal pathway.
